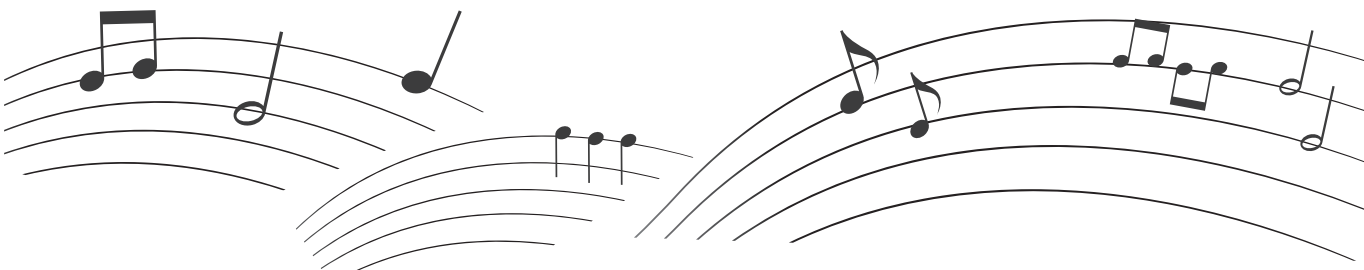

Music Clubs

Two music clubs are offered for student members.

CONBRIOS – Kindergarten - Grade 6 meet the first Friday of the month.

ALLEGROS – Grades 7-12 meet the second Friday of the month.

Both music clubs meet from 4:15 – 5:15 PM at Aquinas College in the Kretschmer Recital Hall. The meetings are held from October through February.

These meetings have programs consisting of fun and educational musical presentations. You'll be inspired by professional musicians, young musicians and talented performers of all kinds. Every music club meeting concludes with performances by student members who want to share their piece they are preparing. This is a great recital opportunity for all students. At the end of each music club meeting, we have a drawing for small gifts.



Community Outreach Programs

We support several local retirement communities. Once a month, in the evening, our students may perform at these retirement communities. These evening recitals are a wonderful benefit not only to our students, but to our community as well.

Federation Festival

GRML members may perform in our annual Festival which is held the last Saturday in February at GVSU. Members play two (2) memorized pieces for an adjudicator. One of these pieces must be listed in the NFMC Bulletin. The adjudicator rates the quality of the member's performance and point values are assigned to their rating. Rating points are accumulative allowing members to earn a Gold Cup Trophy.



Gold Cup Recital

All students who earn a Gold Cup Trophy are invited to perform in a special Gold Cup Recital held at Aquinas College in the Kretschmer Recital Hall. It is at this recital that student members will receive their Gold Cup Trophy. A reception is held following the recital.
